This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders**
Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * **Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521 (ORS 537.746)**
- * **Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits**
New applications received and proposed final orders regarding requests to extend time limits to fully develop water use projects and beneficially apply water.
- * **Application for Instream Lease**
Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.
- * **Transfer Applications: Regular**
Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.
- * **Transfer Preliminary Determinations**
Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, and character of use upon which the public may protest the application and Department's preliminary determination.
- * **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers**
Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.
- * **Transfer Applications: Drought Temporary Transfers**
Requests to temporarily change character of use, place of use or point of diversion during a drought declared under ORS 536.740.

IMPORTANT: Due to COVID-19, the Department's office is closed to walk-in services. The Department encourages the submission of protests by U.S. mail. Please consider mailing early to ensure the Department receives the protest by the deadline specified.

- * **Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments**
Requests to amend permits.
- * **Transfer Notice: District Permanent Transfers for Place of Use- ORS 540.580(4)**
District notices filed for place of use changes within a district's boundary.
- * **Certificate Issuance**

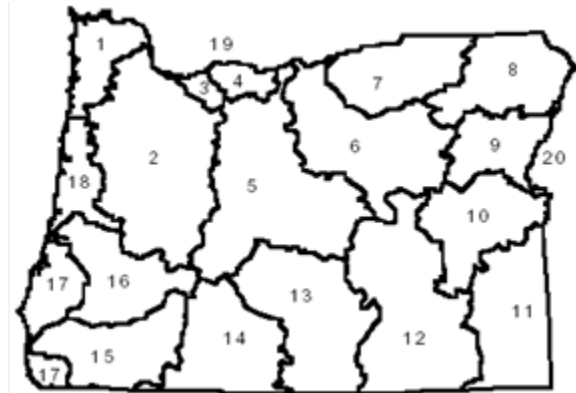

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Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, June 25, 2020. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$30. (Any person paying \$30 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, July 10, 2020.

The protest filing fee is \$410 for the applicants and \$810 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$230 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$580 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

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Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin

ORS 537.746 authorizes the Department to award mitigation credits in the Deschutes Basin to approved mitigation projects. Mitigation credits may be used in the Deschutes Basin, specifically the Deschutes Ground Water Study Area, to mitigate for the impacts of ground water use on surface water flows. Pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521, upon receipt of notification of a mitigation project, the Department shall give public notice of the intent to establish mitigation credits.

The public is invited to comment on establishment of mitigation credits for the project(s) described below. Comments must be received within 21 days of the date of this public notice. Comments should address the award of mitigation credits to the proposed project and its use for mitigation purposes. Included in this public notice is a preliminary determination as to the amount of mitigation credits that may be available from the proposed project.

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Transfer Preliminary Determinations

A Preliminary Determination provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued preliminary determinations on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(2) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than ¼ mile where there are no intervening diversion points.

Any person may protest the application and preliminary determination or may file a standing statement. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030(3) and OAR 690-382-0900, protests must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and include all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position. In addition, protests must be accompanied by a \$810 protest fee for non-applicant and \$410.00 protest fee for applicant. Call (503) 986-0815 to obtain additional information. Protests must be received by the Department on or before June 25, 2020, or within 30 days of the last date of publication in a newspaper, whichever is later. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.

Notice of Preliminary Determination for Water Right Transfer T-12837

T-12837 filed by Andreas and Carole Blech, 1867 Williams Highway #260, Grants Pass, OR 97527, proposes a change in point of diversion, a change in place of use, and a change in character of use under Certificate 3943. The right allows the use of 0.81 cubic foot per second from Grave Creek in Sec. 8, T34S, R5W, WM for irrigation within Sects. 7 and 8, T34S, R5W, WM. The applicant proposes to move the point of diversion in Sec. 8, T34S, R5W, WM and to change the place of use to Sects. 7 and 8, T34S, R5W, WM and to change the character of use to mining uses.

The applicant proposes to move the point of diversion approximately 560 feet upstream on Grave Creek in Sec. 8, T34S, R5W, WM. The Water Resources Department determined that the transfer would injure instream water right Certificate 72697. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) concluded that the transfer would result in net benefits to the resource if conditioned as follows:

- a. ODFW recommends the transfer applicant (permittee) comply with terms of the associated Mitigation Proposal to minimize detrimental impacts to fish, wildlife, and/or their habitat. ODFW understands that the mitigation and following conditions will be fully incorporated into the requirements of the new certificate and may only be altered by written mutual agreement of all parties. ODFW recommends:
 - i) Regulation of the use and/or possible cancellation of the certificate if the required mitigation is not maintained. This recommendation to consent to injury is contingent upon: **implementation of the mitigation measures outlined in the attached Mitigation Plan prior to diversion of water.**

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- b. As required by ORS 509.585, the permittee (transfer applicant) shall not construct, operate, or maintain any dam or artificial obstruction to fish passage without obtaining approval from the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW). The permittee is hereby directed to contact an ODFW Fish Passage Coordinator **prior to construction** of any in-channel obstruction or **prior to diversion** of water that may create an artificial obstruction due to low flow.
- c. The permittee (transfer applicant) shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening on the new point of diversion consistent with current ODFW standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The required screen is to be in place and functional, and approved in writing by ODFW **prior to diversion** of water. The permittee is hereby directed to contact the ODFW Fish Screening Coordinator prior to diversion of water.
- d. If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of *developing the new point of diversion*, the permittee (transfer applicant) shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area in accordance with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Policy OAR 635-415. **Prior to development of the new point of diversion**, the permittee shall submit, to the Oregon Water Resources Department, a Riparian Mitigation Plan approved in writing by ODFW unless ODFW provides documentation that riparian mitigation is not necessary. The permittee shall maintain the riparian area for the life of the permit and subsequent certificate per the approved Riparian Mitigation Plan. If ODFW determines the riparian area is not being maintained, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to fulfill the obligation, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the mitigation is sufficient. The permittee is hereby directed to contact the local ODFW Fish Biologist prior to development of the new point of diversion.
- e. Construction must occur during the established in-water work period (June 15 to September 15) unless otherwise approved by ODFW.
- f. Site-specific condition(s): **Riparian plantings in Mitigation Action 4 must be maintained to ensure a minimum 80% survival five years post-implementation.**

Copies of the OWRD's Preliminary Determination proposing approval of the transfer and ODFW's recommendations are available for viewing at the Salem office of the Water Resources Department. Any person may review the recommendation and submit written comments or may submit a written request for a public meeting to review the recommendation. The comments or request for a meeting must be received by OWRD on or before ____ 2020.

OWRD will provide copies of any comments submitted in response to this notice to ODFW. If a meeting is requested, OWRD will schedule a joint public meeting with ODFW to review the recommendation.

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Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfer

The holder of a water right subject to transfer may request to temporarily change the place of use of the water for up to 5 years and, if necessary to convey the water, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation. The Department shall approve the request provided it does not cause injury to existing water rights or enlarge the water use.
