## HB 2085 (2019)

#### Modernizing Oregon's Dam Safety Program

- Tools to address maintenance & safety issues
- Protect people, property, & infrastructure
- Cooperative plan and timeframe, informal resolution, formal corrective action, injunction, and maintenance action
- General authorities, dam emergency, jurisdiction, modifications, owner responsibilities, safe removal, & civil penalties
- Operative July 1, 2020



## Jurisdiction

Dams Subject to Oregon's Dam Safety Program

- Dams at least 10 feet high and storing over 3 million gallons (9.2 acre feet)
- Statutes apply to dams storing water and wastewater
- Limited role for Federal dams



## **State Regulated Dams**

#### ~ 950 State Regulated Dams

- Hazard Rating
- Dam Inspections
- Condition for High & Significant Hazard Dams

- Corrective & Maintenance Actions
- Modification of Existing Dams
- Removal of Dams
- Incidence Response & Emergency Planning
- Civil Penalties



#### **Designs for New Dams**

- Updates rules for reviewing designs of new construction and adds "to increase dam height"
- Design Review Fee based on actual review time and a cap on the maximum amount is provided

Hazard Rating

• Clarify existing rules to better reflect current technical standards

#### Dam Inspections

• Identify process for communicating with a dam owner through a written inspection summary



#### **Condition for High & Significant Hazard Dams**

 Specify the conditions for which the terms "Unsafe" and "Potentially Unsafe" likely apply

#### **Corrective & Maintenance Actions**

- Clarify actions to be taken when necessary corrective and maintenance actions are unaddressed
- Updated to be consistent with the Administrative Procedures Act (APA)
- Describe the process for working cooperatively with a dam owner or issuing a Proposed Final Order
- Describe the process for when a dam owner requests a hearing



#### **Modifications to Existing Dams**

- Clarify requirements for plans and specifications to be approved
- Specifies changes that are considered modifications
- Provide guidance on when water can be impounded during construction work

#### Removal of Dams

- Outline the process for dam removal and plan
- Department review: may require changes to the plans



Incidence Response & Emergency Planning

• Clarify specific emergency actions to be taken

**Civil Penalties** 

- Outline the schedule for assessing civil penalties
- Provide a process to remit all or a portion of civil penalties
