This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders** Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits New applications received and proposed final orders regarding requests to extend time limits to fully develop water use projects and beneficially apply water.
- * Applications for Limited Licenses Requests to use water for 5 years or less. Licenses are subordinate to other rights and may be revoked if a use is found to injure other water right holders.
- * Application for Instream Lease Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.
- * **Transfer Applications: Regular** Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.
- * **Transfer Preliminary Determinations** Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, and character of use upon which the public may protest the application and Department's preliminary determination.
- * **Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments** Requests to amend permits.

* Water Management and Conservation Plans



Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation. Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use. **The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, August 13, 2020.** Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$30. (Any person paying \$30 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <u>http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/</u>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, August 28, 2020.

The protest filing fee is \$410 for the applicants and \$810 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$230 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$580 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

Applications for Limited Licenses

A limited license allows the right to use or store water for no more than 5 consecutive years. Use of water under a limited license is subordinate to all other authorized uses and may be shut-off at any time to satisfy those other uses. In addition, the Department may revoke a limited license if its use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

Licensees must maintain a record of how much water they are using (ORS 537.143). **The Department** may approve a license after July 28, 2020, upon finding that the proposed water use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-340-030). The public is invited to provide comments that will assist the Director in determining whether the use would impair or be detrimental to the public for a use that is not one of the standard uses listed in OAR 690-300, the Department may, for the pupposes of this notice, assign a named use that is reasonably close to the use actually requested. The public may examine the actual application by clicking the associated hyperlink and then choosing "LL Application" under "Scanned Documents."

Transfer Preliminary Determinations

A Preliminary Determination provides the Department's conclusion as to whether a proposed change in place of use, point of diversion or appropriation, or character of use of an existing water right should be approved. Changes of water rights may be proposed in an application for transfer (including instream, historic POD, exchange, substitution or ground water registration modification).

The Department has issued preliminary determinations on the transfer applications listed below. In addition to this notice, the Department is complying with ORS 540.520(2) that requires publication of notice in a local newspaper for all transfers except those proposing a change in place of use only or a change in point of diversion of less than ¹/₄ mile where there are no intervening diversion points.

Any person may protest the application and preliminary determination or may file a standing statement. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030(3) and OAR 690-382-0900, protests must raise all reasonably ascertainable issues and include all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position. In addition, protests must be accompanied by a \$810 protest fee for non-applicant and \$410.00 protest fee for applicant. Call (503) 986-0815 to obtain additional information. Protests must be received by the Department on or before August 13, 2020, or within 30 days of the last date of publication in a newspaper, whichever is later. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.

<u>T-13118</u> filed by Six Shooter Ranch LLC, 2357 Hillside Road, Richfield, WI 53076, proposes an additional point of diversion and a change in place of use under Certificate 25796. The right allows the use of 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30 from a spring in Sec. 9, T11S, R22E, WM and Girds Creek for irrigation in Sec. 4, T11S, R22E, WM. The applicant proposes an additional point of diversion in Sec. 4, T11S, R22E, WM and to change the place of use to Sects. 4 and 9, T11S, R22E, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

The registration allows the use of 350 gallons per minute from a well in Sec. 28, T4S, R2W, WM for irrigation in Sec. 28, T4S, R2W, WM. The applicant proposes an additional point of appropriation in Sec. 28, T4S, R2W, WM and to modify the place of use to Sects. 28 and 29, T4S, R2W, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the modification, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-382-1000.

<u>T-13351</u> filed by Robinson Best LLC, PO Box 769, Arbuckle, CA 95912, proposes a change in point of appropriation under Certificate 85309. The right allows the use of 0.89 cubic foot per second from a well in Sec. 8, T33S, R7.5E, WM for supplemental irrigation in Sec. 8. The applicant proposes to move the point of appropriation to Sec. 8, T33S, R7.5E, WM. The Water Resources Department proposes to approve the transfer, based on the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000

Notice of Receipt of Recommendation to Consent to Injury for <u>Water Right Transfer T-10898</u>

T-10898 filed by Blue Mountain Angus, LLC, C/O Steve and Carolyn Mullin, 64444 Indian Creek Road, Prairie City, OR 97869 proposes a change in point of diversion and a change in place of use under Certificate 25844. The right allows the use of one-tenth of a cubic foot per second per each one thousand head of stock from Indian Creek in Sec. 3, T14S, R33E, WM for stock use in Sec. 28, T13S, R33E, WM.

The applicant proposes to move the point of diversion approximately 2640 feet upstream on Indian Creek in Sec. 10, T14S, R33E,WM. The Water Resources Department determined that the transfer would injure instream water right Certificate 64193. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) concluded that the transfer would result in net benefits to the resource if conditioned as follows:

- a) The permittee shall not construct, operate, or maintain any dam or artificial obstruction to fish passage without obtaining approval from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW). The permittee is hereby directed to contact an ODFW Fish Passage Coordinator <u>prior to</u> <u>construction</u> of any in-channel obstruction or <u>prior to diversion</u> of water that may create an artificial obstruction due to low flow.
- b) The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening on the new point of diversion consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The required screen is to be in place and functional, and approved in writing by ODFW <u>prior to diversion</u> of water. The permittee is hereby directed to contact the ODFW Fish Screening Coordinator prior to diversion of water. The new point of diversion is currently equipped with an appropriate fish screen.
- c) If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing the new point of diversion, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area in accordance with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Policy OAR 635-415. Prior to development of the new point of diversion, the permittee shall submit, to the Oregon Water Resources Department, a Riparian Mitigation Plan approved in writing by ODFW unless ODFW provides documentation that riparian mitigation is not necessary. The permittee shall maintain the riparian area for the life of the permit and subsequent certificate per the approved Riparian Mitigation Plan. If ODFW determines the riparian area is not being maintained, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to fulfill the obligation, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the mitigation is sufficient. The permittee is hereby directed to contact the local ODFW Fish Biologist prior to development of the new point of diversion.
- d) Construction must occur during the established in-water work period (July 15 August 15) unless otherwise approved by ODFW.

- e) The applicant shall contact ODFW if any issues arise regarding proper function of the fish screen in John Long Ditch and/or the fish passage structure in Indian Creek at John Long Ditch during October-May.
- f) There is currently an ODFW-approved and maintained rotary drum screen in the John Long Ditch and a lay-flat stanchion fish passage structure in Indian Creek. Contacting ODFW during October-May, if issues arise at these structures, is being recommended due to the uncertain nature of maintaining these structures during freezing temperatures in the winter months. Failure of the fish screen and/or passage structure would diminish the benefits derived from this transfer.

The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) concurs with ODFW's finding that overall the project provides a net benefit which offsets the injury to the instream water right caused by this transfer. OPRD supports ODFW's analysis and recommendations dated June 9, 2020.

Copies of the OWRD's Preliminary Determination proposing denial of the transfer and ODFW's and OPRD's recommendations are available for viewing at the Salem office of the Water Resources Department. Any person may review the recommendation and submit written comments or may submit a written request for a public meeting to review the recommendation. The comments or request for a meeting must be received by OWRD on or before August 14, 2020.

OWRD will provide copies of any comments submitted in response to this notice to ODFW and OPRD. If a meeting is requested, OWRD will schedule a joint public meeting with ODFW and OPRD to review the recommendation.
