Note the Commission cannot accept comments on items with an (*), as the public comment period for those items is closed.

Due to the challenge of managing virtual meetings, the public is highly encouraged to send written comments in lieu of oral comments.

Written Comments: Early delivery of written comments is strongly encouraged so Commissioners have sufficient opportunity to review materials prior to the videoconference. *To ensure full consideration by the Commission, written comments must be emailed by 5:00 PM on Tuesday, August 25, to nirvana.cook@oregon.gov.* A confirmation email will be sent. Oral Comments: Oral public comments may be limited to three minutes. Comments relating to a specific agenda item will be heard by the Commission as each agenda item is considered.
