

Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation. Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use. **The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, February 25, 2021.** Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$30. (Any person paying \$30 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, March 12, 2021.

The protest filing fee is \$410 for the applicants and \$810 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$230 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$580 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

In reviewing the applications, the Department will consider whether the diversion for the uses allowed under the original water right will be reduced by the conservation project, whether existing water rights will be protected from injury, and whether the project is in compliance with local comprehensive land use plans.

On December 16, 2020, JTE Ranch, 2672 Galls Creek Rd., Gold Hill, OR 97525, submitted an application for Allocation of Conserved Water under ORS 537.470. Certificate 16212 is for 0.42 cubic foot per second (CFS), from Galls Creek, tributary to Rogue River, for irrigation of 25.0 acres with a priority date of March 1905. The conservation project involves piping 2,200 feet of an unlined ditch and conversion from flood to sprinkler irrigation. The project proposes to conserve approx. 0.20 CFS. The applicant proposes to protect 75% (0.15 CFS) of the conserved water instream.

Proposed Final Orders (PFO's) are the Department's preliminary decision on extension requests. They document the agency's decision through specific findings. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$25. (Any person paying to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued). PFO's may be viewed for free at the Department's Salem Office or at the appropriate watermaster district office.
