PUBLIC NOTICE OF WATER USE REQUESTS
June 1, 2021

This publication lists agency activities requiring public notice. It also describes public comment processes and deadlines. Types of water use requests in this week's Public Notice include:

- * **Permit Application Initial Reviews, Proposed Final Orders, and Final Orders**
Applications for permits to use, store, divert or pump surface water or groundwater. Includes applications by the state Departments of Fish & Wildlife, Environmental Quality or Parks and Recreation for water to be used and kept in-channel.
- * **Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)**
Applications for storage permits for small ponds filed under a simplified review process.
- * **Expedited Secondary Applications to Use Stored Water**
Applications to use stored water exclusively, filed under a simplified review process.
- * **Applications for Allocation Of Conserved Water**
Applications made by a water user who conserves water to use a portion of the conserved water on additional lands, lease or sell the water, or dedicate the water to instream use.
- * **Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521 (ORS 537.746)**
- * **Applications for Extensions of Time to Perfect Water Right Permits**
New applications received and proposed final orders regarding requests to extend time limits to fully develop water use projects and beneficially apply water.
- * **Applications for Limited Licenses**
Requests to use water for 5 years or less. Licenses are subordinate to other rights and may be revoked if a use is found to injure other water right holders.
- * **Application for Instream Lease**
Application by water right holder to lease existing water rights to instream use.
- * **Transfer Applications: Regular**
Requests to change point of diversion or appropriation, place of use, or character of use upon which the public may comment. The changes may be proposed in an application for a transfer (including instream or historic POD), an exchange, or a substitution.

IMPORTANT: Due to COVID-19, the Department's office is closed to walk-in services. The Department encourages the submission of protests by U.S. mail. Please consider mailing early to ensure the Department receives the protest by the deadline specified.

- * **Transfer Applications: Temporary Transfers**
Requests to temporarily change place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the new place of use, to temporarily change the point of diversion or appropriation.
- * **Transfer Applications: Drought Temporary Transfers**
Requests to temporarily change character of use, place of use or point of diversion during a drought declared under ORS 536.740.
- * **Transfer Applications: Permit Amendments**
Requests to amend permits.
- * **Ground Water Registration Modifications**
Applications requesting Department recognition of changes in point of appropriation, place of use and character of use under a ground water certificate of registration.
- * **Certificate Issuance**
Included in this section is a listing of recently issued water right certificates.
- * **Notice of Application to Split a Permit**
Request to assign all or part of a water right permit for irrigation, nursery, temperature control, stock watering, or agricultural water use and to issue replacement permit(s) to reflect an assignment from the current permit holder to one or more additional permit holders.

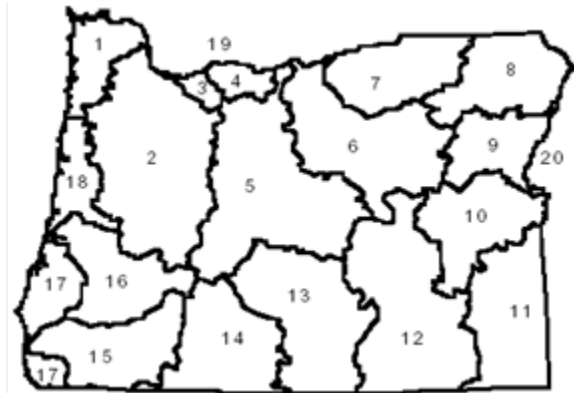

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Initial Review and Proposed Final Orders

The following pages of this notice list permit applications that the Department is evaluating for compliance with state water law. Public participation and comment is encouraged. Opportunities for public involvement vary according to the stage of the permit evaluation.

Ground water permit applications in the Deschutes Basin (Basin 5) may seek to provide mitigation pursuant to the Deschutes Ground Water Mitigation Rules.

Initial Review Stage (IR)

The Department has given the applicant an initial review of water-use restrictions, water availability and other limitations that affect the agency's decision on whether to issue a permit. The Department welcomes comments from interested persons, agencies and organizations on the proposed water use.

The comment deadline for initial reviews appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Thursday, July 01, 2021. Although we cannot respond individually to all comments, each will be considered as the agency makes its decision regarding proposed allocations.

Proposed Final Order Stage (PFO)

The proposed final order is the Department's penultimate decision on the water use request. The PFO documents the agency's decision through specific findings, including review of comments received. If appropriate, it includes a draft permit specifying any conditions or restrictions on the use. Persons interested in receiving a mailed copy of a PFO must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$30. (Any person paying \$30 to receive a PFO by mail will also receive a copy of the Final Order when it is issued.) PFO's may be viewed free of charge online at: <http://apps.wrd.state.or.us/apps/wr/wrinfo/>. Those disagreeing with the Department's decision as expressed in the PFO have 45 days to file a protest.

The protest deadline for proposed final orders appearing in this public notice is 5pm, Friday, July 16, 2021.

The protest filing fee is \$410 for the applicants and \$810 for non-applicants. Detailed requirements for filing a protest are included in the PFO. Persons who support the PFO may file a "standing" fee of \$230 to retain the ability to participate in future proceedings relating to an application. Before participation in a hearing is allowed, an additional \$580 will be required to request to participate as a party or limited party.

If a protest or comment deadline falls on a day that the office is closed, then the next open business day automatically becomes the deadline date.

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Alternate Reservoir Applications (ORS 537.409)

For alternate reservoir applications filed under ORS 537.409, the public is invited to comment within 60 days of this notice. The law provides that within 60 days after the Department provides public notice of the application, any person may submit detailed, legally obtained information in writing, requesting the Department to deny the application for a permit on the basis that the reservoir:

- (A) Would result in injury to an existing water right; or
- (B) Would pose a significant detrimental impact to existing fishery resources as determined on the basis of information submitted by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Such comments must be submitted on or before July 31, 2021.

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Applications for Allocation Of Conserved Water

The following applications for allocation of conserved water have been received pursuant to ORS 537.455 to 537.500 and OAR Chapter 690, Division 18. In reviewing the applications, the Department will consider whether the diversion for the uses allowed under the original water right will be reduced by the conservation project, whether existing water rights will be protected from injury, and whether the project is in compliance with local comprehensive land use plans.

Notice of Application for Allocation of Conserved Water CW-125

On April 14, 2021, James and Jennifer Darby, 1120 Huffman Rd, Suite 24-374, Anchorage, 99515, submitted an application for Allocation of Conserved Water for Certificates 93295 and 93296 under ORS 537.470. Cert. 93295 is for 0.123 cubic foot per second (CFS) from Jimmy Creek, tributary of the Illinois River, for irrigation of 10.0 acres with a priority date of August 18, 1920. Cert. 93296 is for 0.12 CFS for irrigation of 6.0 acres with a priority date of 1888. The conservation project involves converting from flood irrigation and big gun sprinklers to drip and high-pressure sprinkler irrigation. The project proposes to conserve an approx. total of 0.138 CFS. The applicant proposes to protect 25% (0.034 CFS) of the conserved water instream with 0.104 CFS to be applied to new lands.

Any party may provide written comments directly related to CW-125 within 20 days of publication of this notice, **06/03/2021**. Comments should be sent to ACW Program, Water Resources Department, 725 Summer Street NE, Suite A, Salem, OR 97301-1266. WRD will review all comments received when determining whether to approve the proposed conservation project.

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Establishment of Mitigation Credits in the Deschutes Basin

ORS 537.746 authorizes the Department to award mitigation credits in the Deschutes Basin to approved mitigation projects. Mitigation credits may be used in the Deschutes Basin, specifically the Deschutes Ground Water Study Area, to mitigate for the impacts of ground water use on surface water flows. Pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 521, upon receipt of notification of a mitigation project, the Department shall give public notice of the intent to establish mitigation credits.

The public is invited to comment on establishment of mitigation credits for the project(s) described below. Comments must be received within 21 days of the date of this public notice. Comments should address the award of mitigation credits to the proposed project and its use for mitigation purposes. Included in this public notice is a preliminary determination as to the amount of mitigation credits that may be available from the proposed project.

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Applications for Limited Licenses

A limited license allows the right to use or store water for no more than 5 consecutive years. Use of water under a limited license is subordinate to all other authorized uses and may be shut-off at any time to satisfy those other uses. In addition, the Department may revoke a limited license if its use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

Licensees must maintain a record of how much water they are using (ORS 537.143). **The Department may approve a license after June 15, 2021, upon finding that the proposed water use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-340-030).** The public is invited to provide comments that will assist the Director in determining whether the use would impair or be detrimental to the public interest. If the applicant applies for a use that is not one of the standard uses listed in OAR 690-300, the Department may, for the purposes of this notice, assign a named use that is reasonably close to the use actually requested. The public may examine the actual application by clicking the associated hyperlink and then choosing "LL Application" under "Scanned Documents."

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Applications for Instream Lease

ORS 537.348 authorizes a water right holder to lease their existing water right(s) to instream use for a limited time. For the term of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water under the original right. The state is the trustee for water rights leased for instream use. OAR 690-077-0077 requires that the Department public notice the lease applications.

The deadline for submitting claims of injury to existing water rights or enlargement of the original right against a lease application is June 22, 2021. Parties to the lease, including the Department, will review any such claims before the lease is finalized. In addition, protests must be accompanied by the appropriate protest fees. Protests must be received by the Department no later than **July 16, 2021**, (45 days after the notice is published in the Department's weekly notice). If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the Proposed Final Order. Persons interested in receiving a copy of a Proposed Final Order must pay a statutorily-required fee of \$30.
