Division 10 Critical Groundwater Areas

<u>Relating to:</u> Designation of Critical Groundwater Areas

<u>Purpose:</u> Update Division 10 to conform to statute (ORS 537.730 to 537.742)

<u>Scope:</u> Proposed changes provide framework for implementing future CGWA designations according to statute



Division 10 Critical Groundwater Areas

The Rules will Address:

- Required conditions and findings for CGWA designations as specified by statute
- Notice and hearing requirements
- Consultation process with local government(s)
- •CGWA rule requirements as specified by statute
- Corrective control provisions as specified by statute
- Filing and review requirements
- Contested case process



Division 10 Critical Groundwater Areas

The Rules will not:

- Create basin or subbasin specific CGWAs
- Limit groundwater appropriation
- Implement corrective control provisions



Division 54 (New) Conversion of Hydro to Instream

<u>Relating to:</u> Conversions of hydroelectric water rights to instream water rights

<u>Purpose</u>: Establish standards and procedures for conversions (ORS 543A.305)

<u>Scope:</u> Proposed changes guide review and decisionmaking process, establish procedures for notice, and establish standards for approving/denying conversions



Division 77 Instream Water Rights

<u>Relating to:</u> Leases and transfers of existing water rights to instream water rights

<u>Purpose</u>: Clarify application requirements and review processes for leases and transfers of existing water rights instream, improve efficiency of Department review of applications, and implement statutory changes



Division 77 Instream Water Rights

The Rules will:

- Update definitions, correct grammatical and punctuation errors, and clarify application requirements and review process
- Make necessary amendments to implement statutory changes relating to instream leasing
- Streamline process for instream leases involving irrigation districts
- Update lease and transfer sections related to storage rights



Division 215 Water Supply Wells

<u>Relating to:</u> Maintenance, repair, and deepening of water supply wells

<u>Purpose</u>: Replace erroneously repealed section (prior 690-215-0200)

<u>Scope:</u> Proposed change would clarify existing references to repealed section and provide guidance to well owners in three specific geographic locations
