- (3) If verbal approval was granted, a written request must be submitted to the Department either within three (3) working days of the date of verbal approval or prior to the completion of the associated well work. Failure to submit a written request as described above may void prior approval.

NOTICE

This is a final order in other than a contested case proceeding. If you disagree with this order, you may file a petition for reconsideration of the order with the Water Resources Department. If no petition for reconsideration was filed with the agency, you may file a petition for review of the order with the Circuit Court for Marion County or the circuit court for the county in which you reside or do business. A petition for reconsideration or review must be filed within 60 days of the date the order was served. The petition should include the nature of your interest, the facts showing how you are adversely affected or aggrieved by the order and your reasons for reversing or remanding the order. When a petition for reconsideration is filed, the agency has 60 days to respond. If the agency takes no action, after 60 days the petition is deemed denied. You may petition the court for review of the order only within 60 days after agency action on a petition for reconsideration of the order or when the petition for reconsideration is deemed denied.
