FINAL ORDER

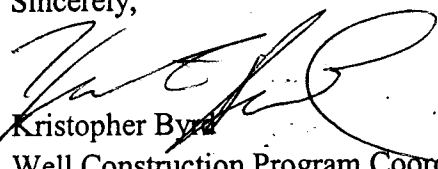
Dear Larry:

The Special Standard request you submitted for owner: Port of Portland (PDX), Start Card numbers 176951 thru 177050 is hereby approved for the following: You may construct up to 100 dewatering wells to a total depth of 20 feet bgs. The wells shall be cased with 10" inch nominal diameter PVC (HDPE) casing. The filter pack shall extend from 20 feet bgs to land surface. These wells shall be permanently abandoned by October 28, 2005. Well Identification labels are not required to be placed on these wells. See Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.789 and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 690-210-0130 and 690-220-0060. All other construction requirements apply. Your Special Standard request form is enclosed.

The Well Construction Standards serve to protect ground water resources. By approving and issuing this special construction standard the Oregon Water Resources Department is not representing that a well constructed in accordance with this condition will maintain structural integrity or that it meets engineering standards. The well constructor/or landowner is responsible for ensuring that a well is constructed in a manner that protects ground water resources as required under Oregon Administrative Rules 690-200 through 690-240.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
